

Youth Camp Packing List

****Please mark all items with Camper's Name**

Clothes: Bring old, destroyable items – you will get wet and dirty at camp.

- ___ Shirts (10): Must cover shoulders and extend over shorts/pants. No tanks, muscle shirts, spaghetti strap or bare midriff shirts.
- ___ Shorts (8): Not overly short
- ___ Pants/Jeans (4)
- ___ Socks (12 pair)
- ___ Sweatshirts/long sleeved shirts (2-3): At least one with a hood
- ___ Light Jacket or Windbreaker
- ___ Water shoes for at the beach: Both toe and heel must be covered or have straps
- ___ Swimsuits (2): Girls – one piece or tankini only
- ___ Pajamas (2)
- ___ Underwear (12)
- ___ Tennis Shoes (2-3): They will likely get wet

Toiletry Items:

- ___ Bath Towel
- ___ Comb/Brush
- ___ Toothpaste/Toothbrush
- ___ Shower Sandals
- ___ Plastic container to carry stuff to and from bathroom
- ___ Wash Clothes/Loofah
- ___ Soap/Shampoo (in plastic containers)
- ___ Deodorant
- ___ Sanitary napkins/Tampons

General Items:

- ___ Sleeping Bag
- ___ Camera (preferably disposable)
- ___ Rain Gear (no umbrellas)
- ___ Beach Towel
- ___ Softball glove (optional)
- ___ Pillow
- ___ Sheets for twin bed (optional)
- ___ Flashlight
- ___ Sport Strap for Glasses/Contact Lens Care Items
- ___ Bike Helmet (camp will provide if you don't have one)

Items Needed During "In-Processing"

****These items will be turned in to camp personnel - keep them accessible for faster check-in**

- ___ \$10-\$20 (optional, for camp museum – will be turned in to camp personnel during in-processing)
- ___ Padlock with 2 keys (will be turned in to camp personnel during in-processing – check with Camp Ripley on appropriate size for use on their trunks as only certain kinds will fit)
- ___ Prescription Medications: **MUST** be in original bottle with doctor's instructions and dosage. They will be turned in to medical personnel during in-processing)

What NOT to bring to Camp:

****You may be asked to leave if these items are found****

- Cell Phones or other electronic devices
- Knives or weapons of any kind
- Matches, lighters, or candles
- Razors/Shaving items
- Make-up
- Pets
- Insect repellent or sunscreen (camp will provide)
- Medications (other than prescription)
- Jewelry (other than studs in ears)
- Fireworks
- Sandals
- Roller Blades/Skateboards/Bikes
- Hair Spray/Hair Dryer/Curling Iron/Straightener
- Perfume or Cologne (attracts bugs)
- Candy/Snacks/Gum (attracts wildlife)
